

2018 ANNUAL REPORT OTD CHILE - ORGANIZING TRANS DIVERSITIES



THE YEAR 2018 PRESENTED ONE OF THE GREATEST CHALLENGES FOR THE TRANS COMMUNITY IN CHILE. NEVER BEFORE HAD OUR EXISTENCE BEEN AS VISIBLE AS DURING THIS YEAR, AND WE ACHIEVED ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT LEGAL ADVANCES SO FAR TOWARD THE RECOGNITION OF OUR IDENTITIES.

The Academy Award for A Fantastic Woman was a historical moment that motivated authorities to accept and recognize the need to keep pushing forward the Gender Identity Law that had been presented to Congress five years earlier. The formation of a Joint Committee, the work of activists, and the power of the reality made this possible, so today we can proudly talk about this legislation, which will come into effect in October 2019.

However, we, the non-binary people, were left out. Even more seriously, children under the age of 14 were denied access to the rights of living with their trans identity. This was a huge disappointment and difficult to accept. This is why we must focus our efforts in order to create a path for them to grow freely and with support. We know that this demonstrates, once again, that our children still are one of the most vulnerable segments of Chilean society.

2018 WAS ALSO A CHAOTIC AND SIGNIFICANT YEAR, BOTH HISTORICAL AND DIFFICULT, BUT IT ALSO TAUGHT US GREAT LESSONS. WE LEARNED TO DEFEND OUR VOICES AND OUR PLACE IN SOCIETY. IN SPITE OF THE VIOLENCE AND DISCRIMINATION WE HAVE EXPERIENCED, WE OPENED UP SPACES THAT USED TO BE UNIMAGINABLE. How? Through our constant work toward visibility. We, THE TRANS IDENTITIES, CAME TO EMPHASIZE AND OCCUPY AN UNCOMFORTABLE PLACE IN THE ("CISTEM") THAT NO ONE CAN DENY US ANYMORE. TODAY, RESPECT FOR SOCIAL NAMES, ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE, DEPATHOLOGIZATION OF TRANS IDENTITIES, AND HORIZONTAL COMMUNICATION WITH THE AUTHORITIES ARE RIGHTS THAT WE ARE INCORPORATING; ALSO, WE ARE GRADUALLY LEARNING TO REPORT CASES WHEN THESE RIGHTS ARE NOT RESPECTED. WE WILL GO FURTHER, AND WE ARE MORE PREPARED TODAY TO UNDERTAKE THE TASKS NEEDED IN ORDER TO MAKE A WORLD FOR, AND WITH, EVERYONE.

IT WAS BORN AS A POLITICAL PROJECT OF CULTURAL TRANSFORMATION WITH A VISION OF THE FUTURE THAT SET THE GOALS WE WANTED TO ACHIEVE FOR OUR COMMUNITY. BY ATTAINING FORMAL STATUS AS A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, WE ESTABLISHED A SOLID ORGANIZATIONAL BASIS THAT ALLOWS US TO MOVE FORWARD TOWARDS OUR GOALS OF TRANS MILITANCY, A MILITANCY WE HAVE BEEN INVOLVED WITH FOR THE LAST TEN YEARS.

WE ARE A MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAM OF PROFESSIONALS, AND TRANS AND CISGENDER ACTIVISTS, WHO WORK TO LINK THE ASSOCIATION WITH USERS AND STAKEHOLDERS. WE BUILD BRIDGES BETWEEN THE TRANS COMMUNITY AND MASS MEDIA, FOCUSING ON TOPICS OF INTEREST FOR BOTH COMMUNITIES.

WHAT WE DO?

THE RESEARCH UNIT OF OTD CHILE IS DEDICATED TO CREATING AND PROVIDING ADVICE FOR RESEARCH ON THE TRANS TOPIC IN CHILE. IT IS RESPONSIBLE OF THE PRODUCTION AND PUBLICATION OF THE T SURVEY. IT HOSTS AND ADVISES STUDENTS, AS WELL AS SOME RESEARCHERS INTERESTED IN PRODUCING RELATED CONTENT.

DURING 2018, THE SITUATION OF INTERSEX PEOPLE IN CHILE WAS PRESENTED IN THE 69TH PERIOD OF SESSIONS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE ELIMINATION OF ALL FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN (CEDAW) IN GENEVA. A SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATION WAS ISSUED TO THE CHILEAN STATE TO LEGALIZE THE TOPIC, AND TO SUPPORT AND MONETARILY COMPENSATE THOSE AFFECTED PEOPLE.

WE ALSO BEGAN RESEARCH ON GENITAL SURGERIES OF UNDERAGE INTERSEX PEOPLE IN CHILEAN HOSPITALS. MOREVOER, WE ARE FINISHING THE FOURTH YEARLY RESEARCH ASSESSMENT OF HOSPITALS REGARDING TRANS SURGERIES. WE TOOK PART IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF QUERIES REGARDING HEALTHCARE SERVICES, AND REGARDING PATHOLOGIZING MEASURES MEASURED WITHIN HEALTHCARE PROTOCOLS.

THE ORGANIZATION WAS A KEY INFORMANT IN THE FONDECYT RESEARCH ON STRESS SUFFERED BY MINORITIES BY PSYCHOLOGY PROFESSOR JAIME BARRIENTOS FROM UNIVERSIDAD ALBERTO HURTADO. HE AND TWO SOCIAL WORK STUDENTS IMPLEMENTED A DIAGNOSIS OF USERS AND EX-USERS TO EVALUATE THE PERFORMANCE OF OTD AS A COMMUNITY SPACE.

WE HOSTED CELESTE ÁMBER MIRANZO, M.A. IN LATIN AMERICAN STUDIES FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, WITH A THESIS ON "TEMPORALIDADES CORPOREIZADAS EN ENTORNOS LGB Y TRANS EN CHILE", DURING HER ACADEMIC VISITING PERIOD. SHE ALSO MADE A PRESENTATION IN THE SEMINARY "TRABAJO SOCIAL Y DERECHOS HUMANOS, RENOVANDO NUESTRO COMPROMISO A 70 AÑOS DE LA DECLARACIÓN UNIVERSAL DE DERECHOS HUMANOS" AT ESCUELA DE TRABAJO SOCIAL DE LA UNIVERSIDAD CATÓLICA SILVA HENRÍQUEZ IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE SOCIAL WORK DEPARTMENT.

WHAT WE DO?

WE PROVIDE GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT TO TRANS PEOPLE, AND FAMILIES OR COUPLES THAT GO THROUGH PEER COUNSELING AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT, WITH THE AIM OF IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF LIFE OF THE CHILEAN TRANS POPULATION IN CHILE.

Many trans people and their families need some guidance and accompaniment during their transition process, as well as empowerment, self-determination, and social expression of their identities). Thus, our organization has a multidisciplinary team which guides those who request such guidance. Every day they write us to address their concerns; these messages are forwarded to the appropriate counselor, according to the needs of each person. The team coordinator assigns three users per week to each counselor, so that they can talk about their trans experience, and receive information about their rights, access to healthcare, psychological support, and relationship with the community, among other matters.

- BETWEEN JANUARY AND DECEMBER, THERE WERE 422 COUNSELING SESSIONS FOR TRANSGENDER PEOPLE, THEIR FAMILIES, OR SIGNIFICANT OTHERS.
- THE 422 SESSIONS CORRESPOND TO A TOTAL OF 161 PEOPLE ATTENDED DURING THIS YEAR. 97 ARE MALE TRANSGENDER USERS, 45 FEMALE TRANSGENDER USERS, AND
 9 NON-BINARY GENDER USERS. TEN ARE FAMILY MEMBERS AND (OR) SIGNIFICANT OTHERS OF TRANS PERSONS.
- THE MAJORITY OF USERS ARE 18 TO 22 YEAR-OLDS, FOLLOWED BY THOSE BETWEEN THE AGE OF 23 AND 27.
- 97% OF THE USERS RECEIVED PEER COUNSELING. THANKS TO THE ADDITION OF A NEW COUNSELOR, THE COVERAGE OF THE SERVICE IMPROVED.
- THE COUNSELORS PROVIDE SOME ONLINE COUNSELING FOR USERS WHO ARE NOT IN SANTIAGO.
- WE ESTABLISHED PARTNERSHIPS WITH EDUCATIONAL CENTERS, HEALTH CENTERS AND/OR PROFESSIONALS TO HELP THEM PROVIDE BETTER ASSISTANCE TO THEIR USERS AND
 PROVIDERS OF HEALTHCARE AND EDUCATION.

WHAT WE DO?

THE OTD CHILE EDUCATION AND TRAINING UNIT CARRIES OUT PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL AND PEDAGOGICAL WORK ON GENDER IDENTITIES AND DIVERSITIES. THE PROJECT, WHICH WAS BORN THANKS TO THE SUPPORT OF THE MISCELLANEOUS GENDER AND SEXUALITIES PROGRAM OF FONDO ALQUIMIA, HAS TWO MAIN AREAS: EXTERNAL EDUCATION AND INTERNAL EDUCATION.

IN EXTERNAL EDUCATION, THE TEAM CARRIED OUT 31 STRATEGIC INTERVENTIONS: WORKSHOPS, TESTIMONIES, FAIRS, TRAINING, COLLABORATIONS, AND OTHERS. IN THESE UNDERTAKINGS, WE SHARED CONTENT ABOUT THE HISTORY OF SEXUAL AND GENDER DIVERSITY, AND TRANS ACTIVISTS AND/OR FAMILY MEMBERS OF TRANS PEOPLE ACTIVELY PARTICIPATED SHARING THEIR EXPERIENCE.

IN THE AREA OF INTERNAL TRAINING, WE ORGANIZED THREE TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR ACTIVISTS:

- SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ACTIVISTS. 8 CLASSES OF 3 HOURS EACH. 18 ENROLLED. 10 REGULAR ATTENDEES.
- QUARTERLY TRAINING PROGRAM. 13 CLASSES OF 2 HOURS EACH. 23 ENROLLED. 12 REGULAR ATTENDEES.
- INTENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ACTIVISTS. 2 AND A HALF DAYS. 27 APPLICANTS FROM ALL OVER CHILE. 19 ATTENDEES.

- 9 WORKSHOPS, 3 TRAINING WORKSHOPS, 4 FAIRS, 10 VOLUNTEER WORKSHOPS, 3 CONVERSATIONS, 2 TALKS.
- More than 400 participants.

WHAT WE DO?

OUR GOAL IS TO BUILD AND STRENGTHEN THE COMMUNITY. WE PROMOTE SAFE SPACES FOR THE EMPOWERMENT OF THE PARTICIPANTS THROUGH DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES: ART-RELATED, SPORTS-RELATED, REFLECTION EXERCISES, ETC. WE MEET WEEKLY IN THE TRANSGENDER MEETING GROUP, A RECURRING EVENT CATERED EXCLUSIVELY TO TRANS PEOPLE.

- Two "Trans Wardrobe", activity where people donate clothing that they no longer use for trans people to pick for free. This is accompanied by sales of food, articles for trans people, etc.

- Bondage workshop. Free activity carried out by volunteer professionals during October, November and January.




